LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1993

PROPOSAL TO DISSOLVE CENTRAL MURRAY COUNTY COUNCIL

A proposal, made pursuant to section 383(1) of the *Local Government Act 1993*, has been received from Murray River Council to dissolve Central Murray County Council and transfer its assets, liabilities and staff to the constituent councils of Central Murray County Council, namely Berrigan Shire Council, Edward River Council and Murray River Council.

The proposal has the support of Central Murray County Council.

Central Murray County Council, which trades under the name of Central Murray County Council Noxious Weeds, is the local control authority for weeds under the *Biosecurity Act 2015* for the local government areas of Berrigan Shire Council, Edward River Council and that part of Murray River Council which was previously the area of the former Murray Shire Council. If the County Council is dissolved, Berrigan Shire Council, Edward River Council and Murray River Council will each become the local control authority for weeds in their respective local government areas.
