



Edward River Council's Rural Tree Planting Scheme allows rural landowners in the Edward River Local Government Area whose properties are larger than five (5) hectares in size to purchase subsidised indigenous plants.

The number of plants is capped at 50 tube seedlings per rate notice, three rate notices per owner. (Maximum order 150 trees.)
