

Edward River Council's Rural Tree Planting Scheme allows rural landowners in the Edward River Local Government Area whose properties are larger than one (1) hectare in size to purchase subsidised indigenous plants.

The number of plants available per annum are:-

Properties One (1) hectare to Ten (10) hectares	50 tube seedlings
Properties Ten (10) hectares to Five Hundred (500) hectares	150 tube seedlings
Properties Five Hundred (500) hectares and over	300 tube seedlings

Orders must be accompanied by a rate notice. Ratepayers are capped at the above number of subsidised tube seedlings irrespective of the number of rate notices.
