



# Rural Tree Planting Scheme 2023 Order Form

Edward River Council's Rural Tree Planting Scheme allows rural landowners in the Edward River local government area whose properties are larger than one (1) hectare in size to purchase subsidised indigenous plants.



The number of plants available per property per annum are:

One (1) hectare to Ten (10) hectares	50 tube seedlings
Ten (10) hectares to Five Hundred (500) hectares	150 tube seedlings
Five Hundred (500) hectares and over	300 tube seedlings

**Ratepayer's orders are capped at the above number of subsidised tube seedlings irrespective of the number of rate notices.**

**Completed order forms must be returned to Edward River Council by Friday 23 September 2022 - Late orders cannot be accepted.**

Orders must be accompanied by payment and will be checked to confirm ownership and holding size prior to processing

Please order a minimum of five (5) seedlings per species and in lots of five.
